

HHHi fellow Hashers and Happy St Andrews Day for Friday!!!

It's been a while since you last heard from us. We wanted to finalise as many things as possible rather than spamming you with the updates, however the booking system has taken longer to develop than planned due to changing the method in which the booking system will operate so wanted to give a quick update as to where we currently stand.



### Cabin bookings

The cruise company's booking system is set up for their own cruises which is based on couples or families booking a cabin, and not for lots of singles booking. The system that was initially offered was based on booking of cabins, however as this would not have worked for the majority of singles attending, a bespoke booking system has had to be developed. This is being finalised by our cruise partner and will be available for testing shortly and should be available for booking early in the New Year. This has taken much more effort than expected but we are almost there!



Once we can confirm the exact dates we will send out emails detailing how and when your bookings will be made. Please do not contact the cruise company as bookings will only be able to be made via this online portal. In relation to prices, this info has been shared previously and a high-level cost is available on the website under FAQs. As the event is being run as a not for profit event, pricing is key, to ensure that you are not overcharged but also to ensure a loss isn't made.



### Run selection

As part of the booking, you will be able to select your run preference for each day. Based on this information, we will (if required) adjust trail lengths to correspond to this and closer to the time you will be able to pre-book your run for each day. If you were over ambitious or unable to book the run you wanted, these can be changed on the day via the swapping of wristbands.

### Red Dress Run

This will be a spectacular opportunity to run around the great city of Edinburgh and see the sights and sounds of the capital of Scotland. We will then be asking that age-old question – “can we organise a piss up in a brewery?” – Well the answer is yes, as we have an entire brewery to ourselves! Here, not only will you be able to sample a range of some of the best beer Scotland has to offer, but you will also be able to enjoy the spectacular entertainment we have on offer for you. How do I register for this great event – well that is simple, you are already registered as part of your registration. All you have to do is ensure you have somewhere to stay in Edinburgh on Wednesday night. Check out our website for some useful links to accommodation.



### Registration and cruise departure

We will be offering shuttle busses from Inverkeithing to the cruise terminal, which can easily be reached via a 20-minute train journey, running roughly every 15 minutes from the centre of Edinburgh. Alternatively, car parking will be available and this can be booked as part of your cabin booking. You will be allocated rough arrival slots, where you will register for the ship and once on-board your great selection of haberdashery will be awaiting you in your cabin. You will need a valid passport, even if you are from the UK, so ensure that your passport is valid until 19<sup>th</sup> August 2019!

## Island locations

Some great work has been done by our teams on the Orkney and Shetland Islands. Trails have been recce'd, halls and busses booked, entertainment put in place, pubs notified and the locals are really looking forward to showing you the greatness of the northern isles. Just to make sure that we do not run out of beer, one of the local hashers has even taken over one of the local breweries!



## Sunday Arrival

Upon arriving back in Rosyth on Sunday morning you will be bussed to another treasure of Scotland, via one of our numerous run sites, to show you that it is not just the great cities or islands that are captivating. From here, you will then be transported to our final location for a spectacular closing party. For those that are driving, you will be able to select from a range of runs and directions will be issued to you for routes to and from the run location.



## Final location

We have a fantastic location lined up that we're really excited about! However, contracts cannot be signed until December and so we will be able to release these details, once this contract is signed - which should be in December or January. The location will be an easy commute of less than 2 hours to both Edinburgh and Glasgow airports via public transport, with plenty of accommodation on tap. It will also be within easy commute of the rest of Scotland and, most importantly, easy to make your way to UK Nash Hash 2019.
